1. INVITATION:

CORK/Sail Kingston invites sailors in the **Laser, Laser Radial (Men and Women), Finn, 49er, RS:X, Windsurfer, Bic 293, Kiteboards and 29erXX** classes to the **CORK OCR Regatta** in Kingston, Ontario, home of **CORK Sail Week®**.

- NA Grand Prix ranking event for **the Laser and Laser Radial Classes**
- ISAF Grade One event for **men sailing in the Laser Class and women sailing in the Laser Radial Class.**
- **Medal Races** are scheduled for the **49er & 29erXX** classes on the last day of the event. Addendum Q may not apply. Medal races may be scheduled for other classes that express an interest.
- **RS:X, Kiteboards, Bic 293 & Windsurfer classes** – This is a **5 day** event for **RS:X and Kiteboards**. On two of the days a slalom section may be included as part of the course. It is a **3 day** event (August 20, 21 & 22) for **Bic 293 and other windsurfers.**

2. SITE:

The regatta will be sailed from Portsmouth Olympic Harbour (POH), site of the 1976 Olympic Sailing events, the 2007 Volvo Youth Sailing ISAF World Championship World and the 2010 Optimist North American Championship. Racing will take place on the fresh waters of Kingston Harbour.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

The Regatta is open to members of the invited classes who have met all class membership and measurement requirements. (For the 29erXX and 49er classes all participants **MUST** be members of the Class Association.) Participants must have completed registration and paid all event fees before beginning official competition.

4. MEASUREMENT:

Competitors are responsible to ensure their boat and equipment complies with applicable class rules. Measurement checks may be conducted as per class requirements and competitors must be prepared to present their measurement certificate if requested.

5. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. In the event of conflict in any translation, the English version will prevail.

5.1 Only the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association to rule 68 and all the prescriptions to Appendix F Will apply. They can be found on the CYA website <http://www.sailing.ca> . They will be stated in full in the Sailing Instructions.

5.2 RRS Appendix P will apply.

5.3 Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

5.4 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6. ENTRY & FEES: (Credit cards, Debit Cards, Money Orders, Bank Drafts or cash)

If the completed entry form and entry fee is received at the CORK/Sail Kingston office, on or before July 31, 2011:

The single handed Early Bird Entry Fee is **CDN \$210.00 + 13% HST**

For windsurfers 3 day event the Early Bird fee **CDN \$150.00 + 13% HST**

The double handed Early Bird Entry Fee is: **CDN \$320.00 + 13% HST**

Entry fees cover racing, a light dinner and snacks after racing, a regatta souvenir and a per diem fee to the City of Kingston for use of facilities.

8. QUALIFYING SERIES: - LASER, LASER RADIAL

If, by the end of registration on Friday, August 19th, any of the above classes has over 80 registrants, there will be a qualifying series for that class.

9. COACHES and COACH BOATS:

Coaches and press must register. On line registration is available at www.cork.org Coaches will be issued a numbered flag which they must display while in the racing area and are expected to monitor a CORK safety channel on their VHF radios, be available to assist in an emergency and attend the coaches meeting each morning. There is no coach fee but a \$20.00 deposit for the flag is required.

10. PRIZES & AWARDS:

In consultation with the class associations, CORK provides a variety of awards. For each One-Design fleet with over 6 entries, CORK/Sail Kingston medals will be awarded to the top three finishers. Additional prizes will depend upon the number of competitors in the fleet. Some class associations may provide their own additional awards.
